

ADMISSION POLICY

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this procedure is to establish clear guidelines regarding admission to various courses conducted by SACOE.

2. SCOPE

The entry requirements for each course of SACOE are defined in terms of stated qualifications or their equivalents, and are intended to facilitate assessment of the candidate's ability to meet the demands of the course.

3. RESPONSIBILITY

Management, Principal and Administration

4. TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMMES OFFERED

The college offers two teacher education professional courses namely B. Ed and M.Ed. Each course is of two years' duration comprising of four semesters. The courses are affiliated to Osmania University and approved by NCTE.

5. CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

5.1 B. Ed.

SACOE is established exclusively for women candidates. Even though the minimum eligibility for the course is graduation, post graduates are also eligible to join the course. Students are admitted into the College according to the percentage of seats allotted in each discipline by the Government of Telangana.

- 25% for Social Studies Methodology
- 25% for Mathematics Methodology
- 20% for Biological Sciences Methodology
- 10% for Physical Science Methodology
- 10% for Telugu 1 – Methodology
- 10% for English 1 – Methodology

All the students are admitted on the basis of merit secured in the Ed. CET and through counseling and spot admission for vacant seats. Christian Minority students are given preference under the same norms.

5.2 M.Ed.

SACOE offers a post graduate course in Education from the Academic Year 2002. Candidates who have secured 55% and above in the B. Ed course and 36 marks and above in the M. Ed entrance examination conducted by Osmania University are eligible to apply through counseling and spot admission/ management seats for vacant seats

ADMISSION NOTIFICATION
