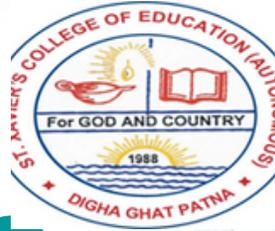
About the Collaborating Institutions
