

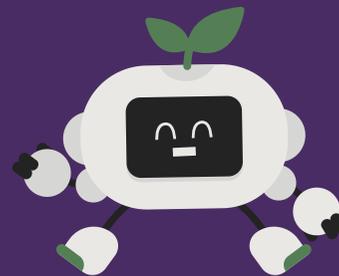
About Us

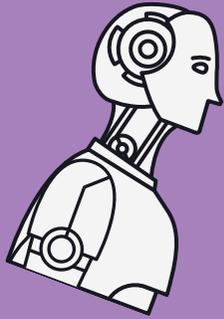
